TEACHER OF TECHNOLOGY (inc. FOOD TECHNOLOGY)

We are seeking to appoint a qualified teacher of Technology with the enthusiasm and interest to become fully involved in all aspects of the subject and capable of fostering sound, respectful relationships with students. You need to be a team player, who is committed to working alongside other colleagues to develop teaching and learning within the Visual Arts and Design Faculty. There is also a lot of scope for involvement in educational visits and extra-curricular activities. Candidates would ideally be expected to teach 3D Design to A Level and Food Technology to GCSE. Applications from newly qualified teachers or experienced teachers are equally welcome.

Facilities

We are well resourced and friendly Faculty, with each teacher having their own teaching room. The Faculty has access to a range of audio-visual resources and computer rooms and comes from a legacy of an exceptionally well-resourced visual arts school specialism. The Visual Arts and Design team are friendly, welcoming, professional and mutually supportive. Their teaching sits at the forefront of evidence-based practice.

Courses

We follow the National Curriculum in Key Stage 3 where classes are taught in mixed ability groups. All students have both technology and food technology lessons in KS3 before selecting their options for KS4 study during Year 9. For GCSE from 2020, both Food technology (Eduqas) and 3D Design are offered (AQA), with a great deal of professional support available as we launch the Food course for the first time in our new food tech room. Our record of success in public examinations is good with students achieving well overall. A Level outcomes in 3D Design are improving year-on-year and uptake is positive and stable. At GCSE a recent shift from Product Design GCSE to 3D Design is leading towards positive outcomes too. The Visual Arts and Design Faculty also offers courses at either GCSE or A Level in Photography or Art.
