

## Accessing Your Son/Daughter's Report On EduLink One

Dear Parent/Carer,

This guide shows you how to access your son/daughter's report for this term. Please remember that the report for Year 11s this term is the mock exams results that were handed out at the recent Parents' Evening event.


You will have received two pieces of correspondence from the school to help you log into EduLink One. The first was a letter that contained your username, which was given to your son/daughter in school for them to hand to you personally. The second letter was posted out to you and contains the password to enable you to log in.

### Step 1

Go to the website <https://qphs.edulinkone.com>

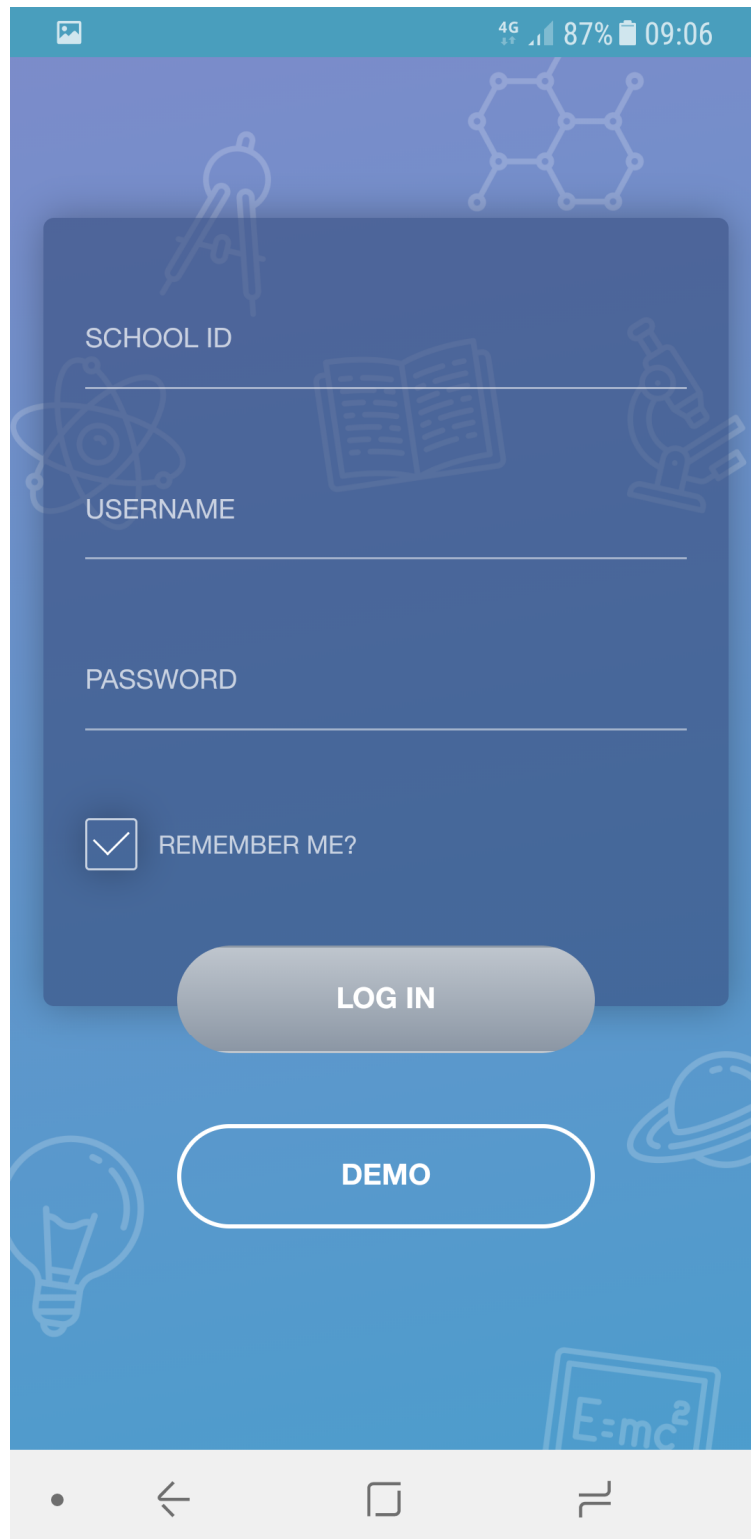
This will come up with a login box where you can enter your username and password. It looks like the screen below. Once you have entered your details please click onto the 'Log In' button.

You can also login using the EduLink One App on your Apple or Android device. After downloading the App for free, you can login using your username and password.

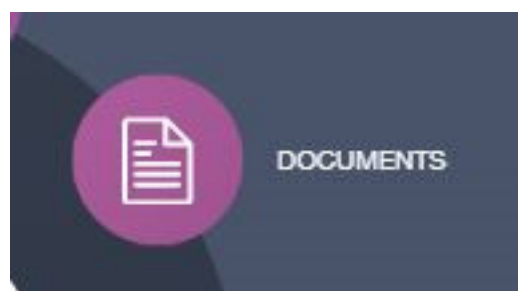
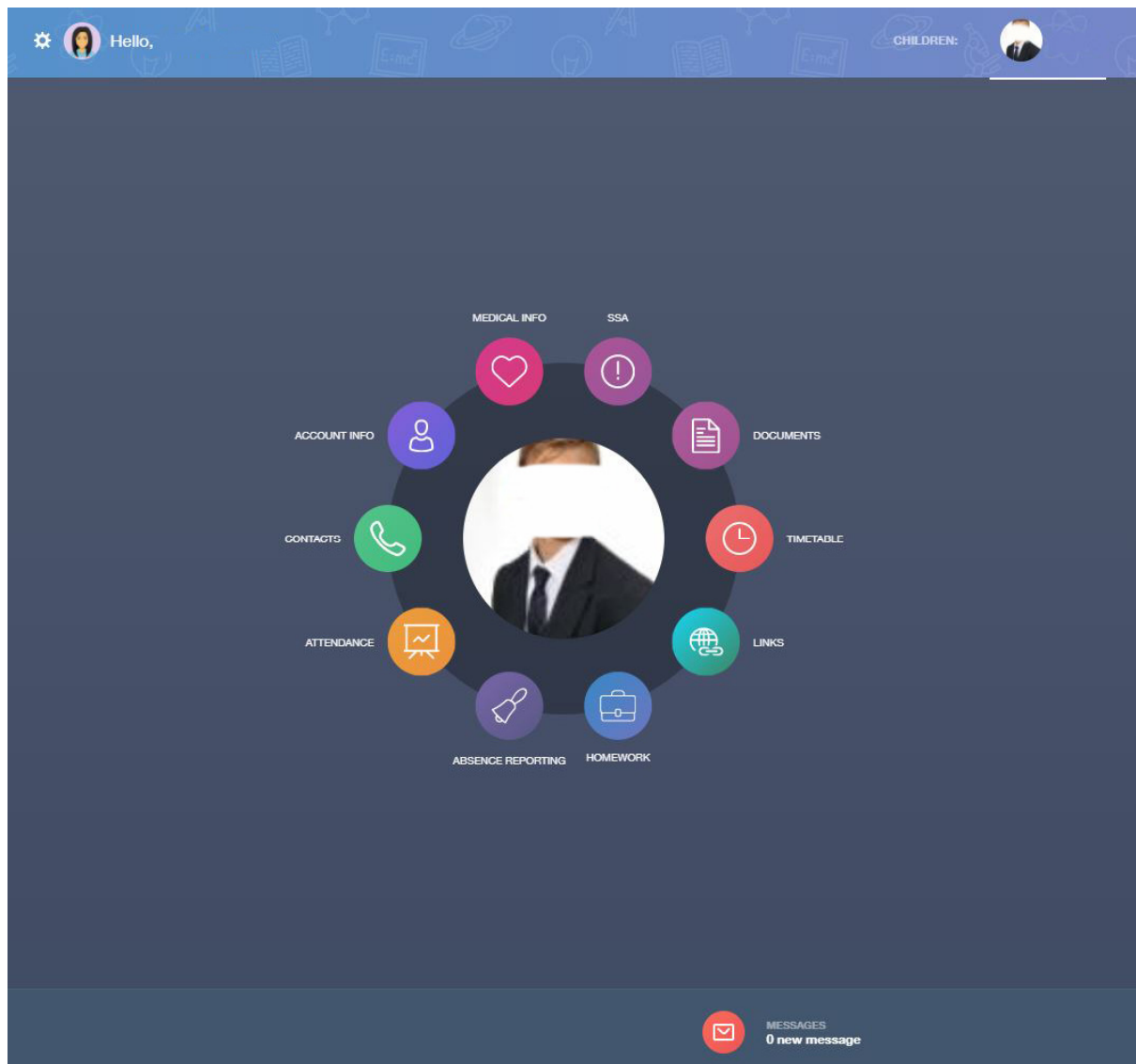
Please note on the App you need to use a school ID. The school ID is **QPHS** (which is not case sensitive).



## Step 2

Once you have logged in you should see a picture of your son/daughter surrounded by lots of different menus. If you have multiple children in the school they will all appear on the top right hand side of the page.


On the screen you need to click on the 'Documents' menu.





