I would like to formally invite you and your parents/carers to our Sixth Form Open Evening which is taking place at school on Wednesday 30<sup>th</sup> January. The evening runs from 6.30-8.00pm and is an opportunity for you to come and find out more information about the Sixth Form here at Queen's Park, the courses on offer and the wider opportunities you can engage with in order to support your education and future pathways.

We are very proud of our Sixth Form and without fail, our students go on to achieve great things both during and after their time here. As well as being taught by experienced teachers in a range of subjects, you will benefit from refurbished space and facilities, including a study room, and common room with Wi-Fi access to support your work outside of lessons, dedicated space within the LLC and your own on site Sixth Form Café, 'The Beach'.

At our Open Evening, you will be able to find out detailed information about the Sixth Form, the subjects you could study, and information about where our Sixth Form is leading our current students and most recent leavers. There will be current Sixth Form students available to speak to about courses and Sixth Form life, who will be able to give you the 'behind the scenes' view. An independent Careers Advisor will also be present to support with impartial advice should you require it.

Making decisions about the next stage in your education can be difficult and it is therefore crucial to get all of the information you can. Even if you've got ideas that don't currently include studying in the Sixth Form, I would encourage you to come along as there are a range of options to suit the vast majority of you.
